

The Virginia Legislative Ministry Needs Volunteers:

- to communicate directly with their elected officials in their districts and build a relationship over time with the officials and staff.
- congregation liason to foster UULM-VA in their congregations and coordinate education and action on priority issues with which the congregations wish to engage.
- Richmond Corps, to go to Richmond to attend rallies, hearings, meetings with legislators, etc.
- Board of Directors, who represent regions across the state, experts on priority issues, members with special skills, talents, or expertise such as fundraising, technology, and public relations.
- Issue Task Force, to stay informed on the issues, educate and mobilize their congregations
- skills to share including : communications/PR; information technology; fundraising; photography/video; graphic design; youth involvement; attending hearings, rallies, etc.; advocacy
