**OPPOSE:**

**HB 1414 Government-issued licenses, etc.; obtaining or renewing, conscience clause.**

**HB 1427 Death caused by a Schedule I or II controlled substance; penalty.**

**HB 1296 Members of the United States Congress; filling vacancies.**
